

This linocut, found after Moore's death, was printed as a bookplate measuring 145 x 95mm and mounted on to the half-title page of a biography of Albrecht Dürer (by L. Jessie Allen, Methuen, London, 1903). The print is undated, but the book bears the signature Hal. S.
