On the occasion of the exhibition of <i>Henry Moore and the Challenge of Architecture</i>, at The Henry Moore Foundation, Perry Green. Front Row presenter Mark Lawson interviews with Timothy Llewellyn, conservator Malcolm Woodward and curator Anita Feldman Bennet; <i>Mirror Knife Edge 1977 bronze</i> (LH 714); <i>The Arch 1979-80 travertine</i> (LH 503c) in Kensington Gardens, London; Moore as Yorkshire man; visit to Perry Green; Bourne Maquette Studio (collection of stones and flints); Moore didn't want sculpture to be sub-servient to architecture. In response to the deterioration of <i>The Arch</i>, Italian American tycoon Carlo Bilotti met the Royal Parks to offer to buy the sculpture and replace it with a replica. This was denied.
