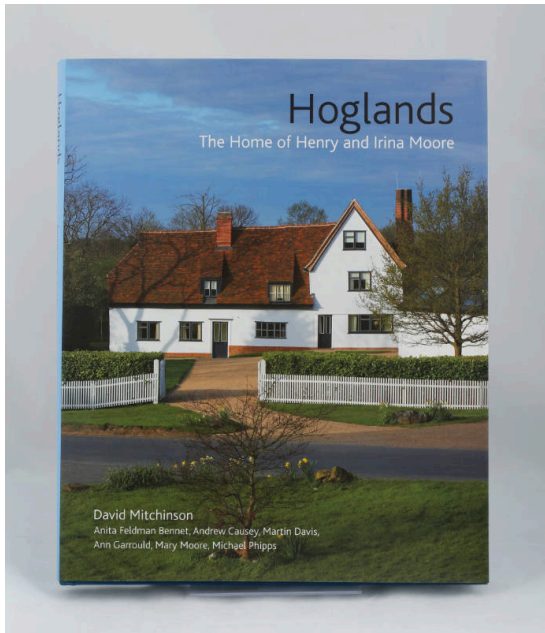

## Description

Book published to coincide with the opening of Hoglands to the public after two years of renovation. Densely illustrated with photographs, many of which previously unpublished, the book traces the development of the house, Moore's studio, Irina's garden and their art collection from the early 1940s to the late 1980s, placing the social history of the building within the broader context of Moore's life and work.
