

Foreword by Richard Calvocoressi. Chapters on "Henry Moore: At Perry Green", "Henry Moore: A Life", "Henry Moore: At Home", "Henry Moore: At Work", and "Henry Moore: Sculptures". Illustrated throughout with colour photographs of Moore's works, the estate, and biographical images of Moore and his family. Ch.1 discusses the history and collection of the Henry Moore Foundation, and the make-up of the estate; ch.2 is a brief biography and timeline of Moore's life; ch.3 discusses the Moores' life at Hoglands, and its acquisition and restoration by the Foundation, with photographs both of the house after being restored in 2007 and Moore and his family in the house; ch.4, Moore's studios and working practices; and ch.5 talks about a selection of Moore's sculptures owned by the Foundation, including photographs of them on display in the grounds.
