

Str. This exhibition is the first time that the work of these two Artist's has been showcased together providing an examination of their work and the parallels that can be drawn between them. Anita Feldman's introduction on Page 11 sets the context; "the two artists pioneered and shared a coherent vision and approach to modernism" and "used natural forms as a pathway to abstraction" focusing their work around these natural forms and both amassing vast collections of natural objects over the course of their lifetimes.<br/>
