[Pierre Lecuire Paris] MCMLXXIV Published as a book in deluxe and standard editions containing a text in French by Pierre Lecuire consisting of twenty-two previously unpublished poems, and twenty-two prints by fifteen artists after the etching Les Trois Livres by Hercules Seghers. There are two prints each by Vera Pagava, Arpad Szenès, Brigitte Simon, Vieira da Silva, Henry Moore (no.12, CGM 172; no.14, CGM 171), Charles Marq, Claude Garache, and one each by Pierre Tal-Coat, Raoul Ubac, Geneviève Asse, Étienne-Martin, César, Fermin Aguayo, Jean Messagier and Serge Charchoune, all of which are unsigned.
